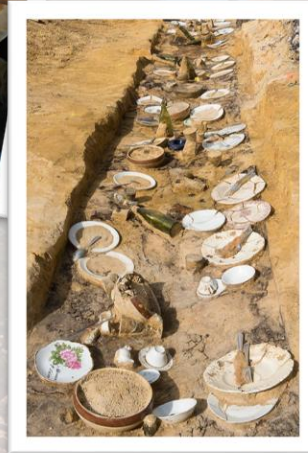
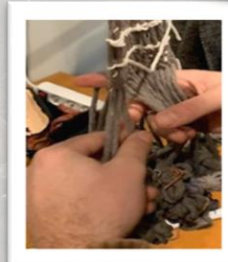

## How can archaeology, the science of the past par excellence, contribute to enlightening the present and preparing the future?

The *Ecole Universitaire de Recherche (Graduate Research School) ArChal*, is a beneficiary of the 2019 *Investissements d'Avenir* program. Led by the University of Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne the EUR ArChal is supported by seven partner institutions in France, Germany, Spain and Italy.

The EUR ArChal is at the origin of the **creation of a unique platform for European cooperation** in both archaeological teaching and research. The synergy between the partners involved in this EUR is guaranteed by the sharing of **research themes, scientific and ethical values.**

### *A project based on four major challenges*

- 1- Environment and climate change
- 2- Power and inequalities
- 3- Conflicts, mobilities and migrations
- 4- Technology and innovation

### Our aims

- To offer innovative training in **cutting-edge archaeological methods and techniques.**
- To develop original **European teaching** and research projects (masters, PhDs, scientific projects) **on research topics related to current global challenges** and on the **role of archaeology in the implementation of sustainable strategies to cope with the challenges of the future.**
- To **strengthen the professionalization of students** through this dual approach.

## Master: Training and certification

Each year EUR ArChal launches a call for applications in October. A maximum of 15 students are then selected to join the 2-years class.

### A complementary training to the Master's degree

- Intensive training (lectures, hands-on workshops, Season Schools...)
- Mobility grants will allow students to participate in internships or training courses given in Paris, Berlin, Madrid and Bologna.
- Students will develop collective projects in line with the EUR challenges.
- Once the first year of Master validated, students will continue this training in their second year of Master.

At the end of these two years training, **a university diploma (DU) specific to EUR ArChal** will be awarded by the University of Paris 1. This **certification of skills and knowledge** will be added to your Master's degree and enhance it.

## Doctoral training and PhD scholarships

Each year (call in April) –

### **3 PhD scholarships of 3 years duration.**

Applications are examined by a committee composed of representatives of all the partners. The selected students will be enrolled for their PhD in Archaeology at the University Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne (ED 112). **Joint supervision with another partner university is highly recommended.**

The PhD students will participate in teaching (lectures, tutoring) and in the scientific development of the EUR through their research projects that address one or more of the EUR's challenges.

## Master – Who can apply?

- Students registered in the first year of a Master's degree in archaeology, as well as in cultural heritage, restoration-conservation or art history, at the **University of Paris 1** or at one of the **partner universities:**

*Freie Universität Berlin*  
*Universidad Complutense Madrid*  
*Università di Bologna*  
**INALCO**

- A good level of English and a good understanding of French are required.
- No restrictions on age or nationality.

## PhD scholarships - Who can apply?

- Holders of a Master degree in archaeology, in cultural heritage, in restoration-conservation or in art history from the **University of Paris 1** or one of the **partner universities.**
- PhD thesis projects must be clearly related with one or more of the EUR ArChal's four challenges
- A good level of English and French is required.
- No restrictions on age or nationality.
